

Verbs and Tenses

A Verb is a word that expresses action or a state of being. When it expresses the action, the verb tells either what someone or something does or what is done to someone or something.

Example: He wrote the letter. Or: The letter was written by him.

Main verbs of two kinds

Regular Verbs: These verbs take 'd' or 'ed' for past forms.

Examples: ask asked, love loved
